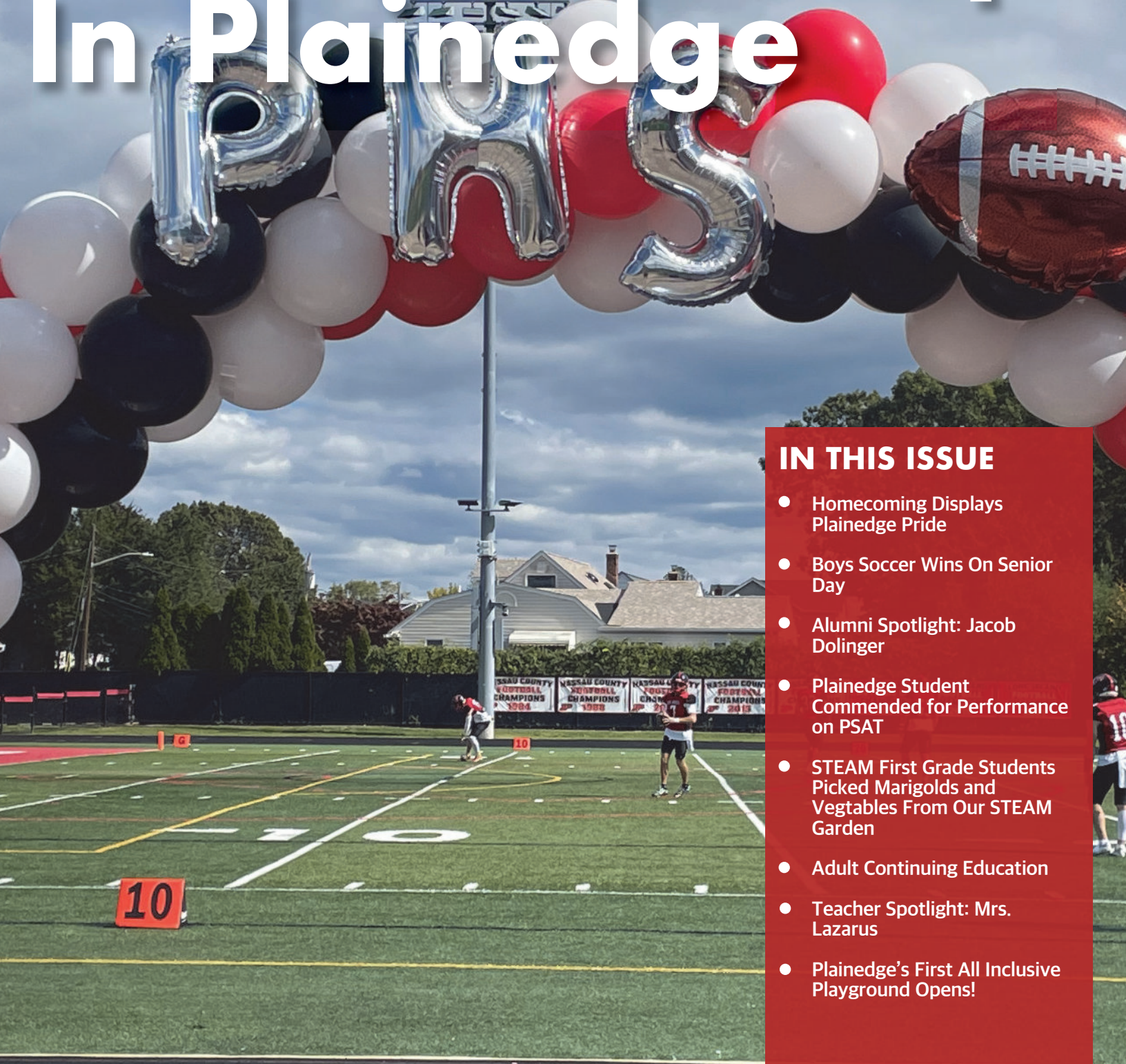

Alumni Spotlight: Jacob Dolinger

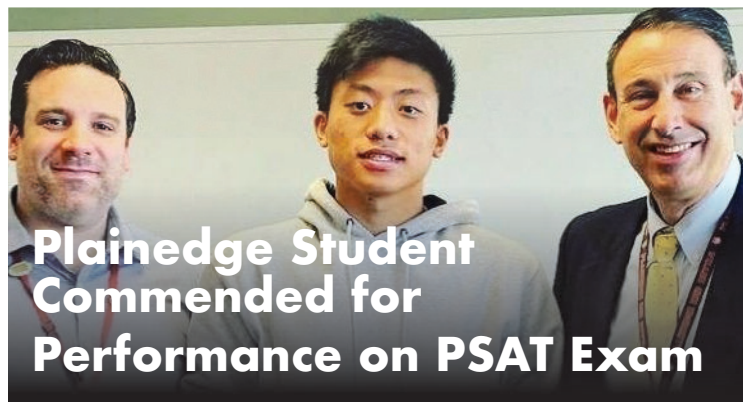


