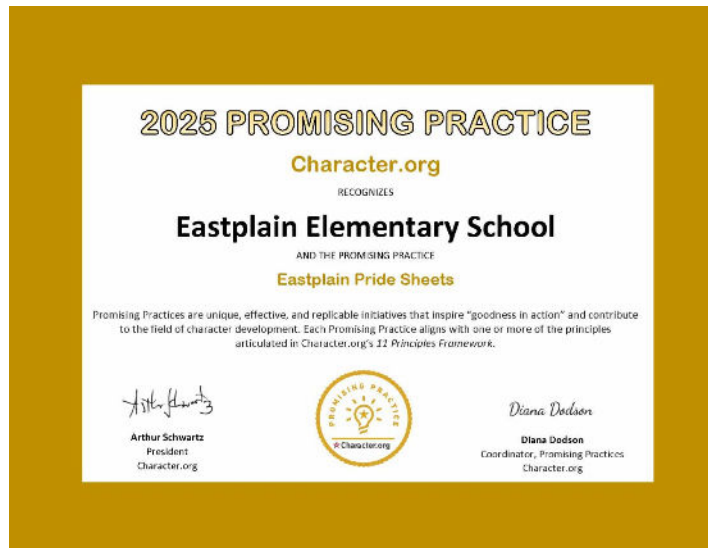
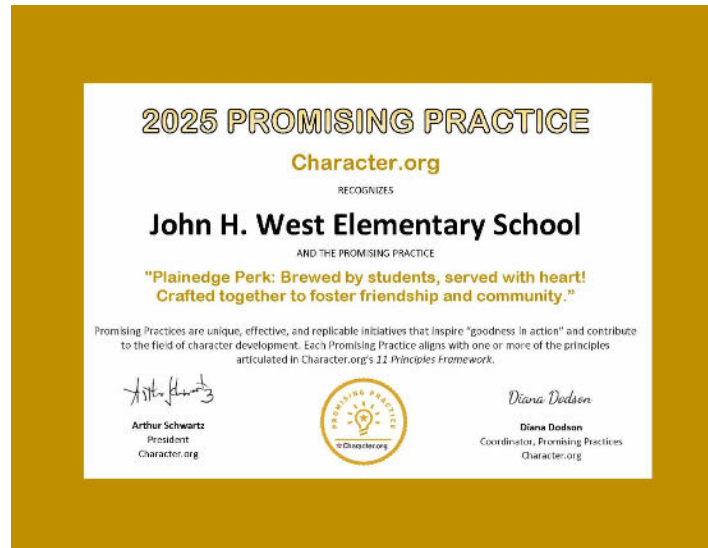

This innovative coffee shop transforms Friday mornings into a celebration of inclusivity and teamwork. The student council members guide their special education schoolmates through the art of brewing delicious coffee, creating an engaging, hands-on experience that fosters essential people skills. Our initiative creates a caring community where everyone feels a strong sense of belonging, as student council members mentor their special education peers, offer guidance and encouragement while learning valuable social skills together. By demonstrating respect for one another, being responsible in their tasks, and fostering an inclusive atmosphere, students actively contribute to a culture where everyone feels welcome. The coffee shop becomes a pivotal space where our core values come to life.

Eastplain Elementary School - Eastplain Elementary School - “*Eastplain P.R.I.D.E. 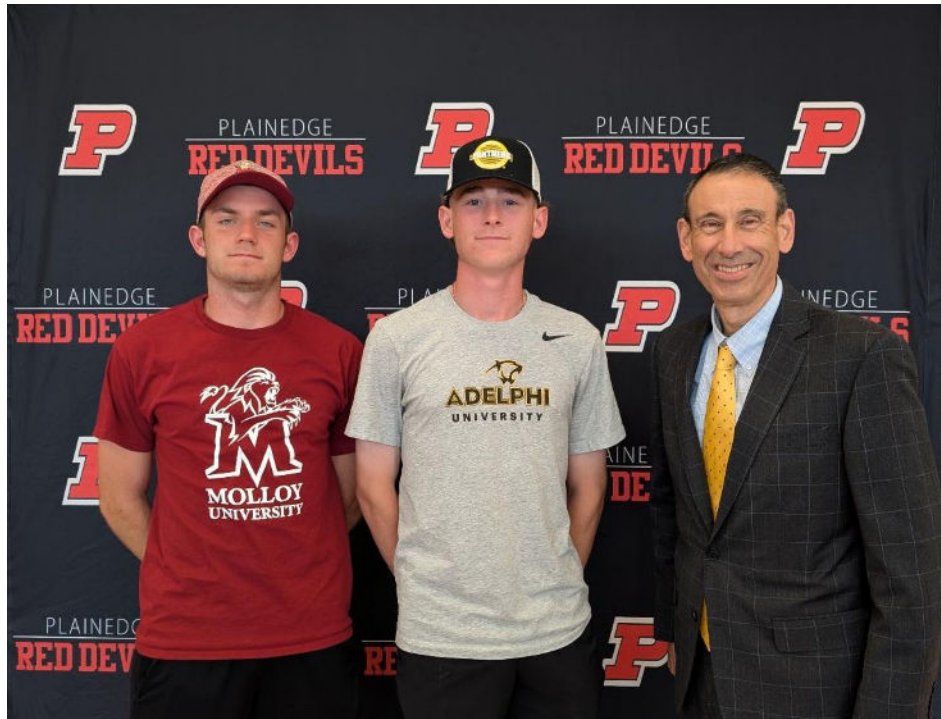

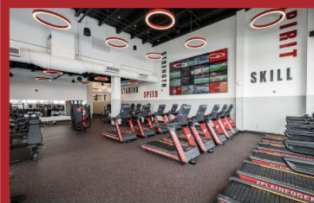
